You will like her even more when you study her pedigree. Set aside the Carbon Copy sire and the M&M Outsider on her bottom side and focus in on TR Ms. Wyoming Wind 5604R on the bottom side of her dam. 5604R is the dam of 149 progeny in the AICA database including TR Ms. Wylie Fire 0761X, owned by Wild Indian Acres, Zehnder and Southern, as well as the \$105,000 TR Ms. Montella 1572Y. Many young daughters of 5604R are just entering the prime of their lives. Females that look the part and are bred like this don't come around very often.
