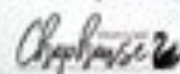

**57 Plus Years of Angus Heritage & Five Generations**



Whitestone Pilgrim

Paul (Bud) Haag and Betty Steiler married on January 13, 1952 in Plymouth, Indiana and had two children, Michael Haag and Margaret Haag. In 1965, our Angus story started as Mike became a lifetime member of the American Angus Association and established Haag Angus Farm. In that same year, Bud and Mike purchased their first two Angus heifers from a Grimm Angus Sale in Bourbon, Indiana, the pair of heifers were of the Bardolomew breeding and served like so many Angus herd starts, a 4-H project for Mike and his sister, Margaret.

On April 12, 1967, Mike and his father traveled to Woodburn, Indiana where they purchased Royal King W8 60, Registration 5291558, for \$1,100 as Lot 33 in the Woodworking Brothers Complete Dispersal Sale where his sire, Costarion Royal King, was the \$43,500 top-selling Lot 1 bull and his dam, Edwina P5, was the \$1,700 second top-selling female. His full sister was a first prize winner of both the National Western and the All American, and their sire regaled as the Grand Champion Bull of both the 1963 Illinois and Indiana State Fairs, sired by the 1958 International Grand Champion Bull, Don Macs Bardolomew 100.

Although Paul's father raised some Angus cattle, Paul and Mike's passion for Angus cattle grew when Bud and Mike attended many shows and county fairs around the country. One summer day, while Mike was at the LaPorte County Fair, he met the love of his life, Peggy Rada. Mike and Peggy married on September 23, 1978. This is also the year they established Pilgrim Angus and began their own journey in the Angus business. In September of 1979 their first son, Jeremy, was born and in July of 1982, Chad came along.

As they continued their journey in the Angus business, their sons grew the same passion and competed at the national, state, and local levels with their Angus cattle. In 1995, they had the Grand Champion Bull at the Indiana Angus Futurity Show and Sale purchased by Whitestone Farms of Aledo, Virginia and later was named Whitestone Pilgrim, who the next year was selected as the 1996 Grand Champion Bull of the Atlantic National ROV Angus Show. In 1998, the Haag brothers found success at the Indiana State Fair showing the Champion Angus Female in the Junior Show at the Indiana State Fair, with Pilgrim Rachel 1297, whose descendants are still carried on in this event. In 2000 they also had success winning the Junior Show at the Indiana State Fair with Vision MAF Forever Lady 9018.

Following the boys' junior show careers, they both went to further their education with Jeremy graduating from Purdue University and Chad from Joliet Jr. College. Jeremy started his career at the American Gelbvich Association as a regional manager then pursued his childhood dream of being in the sale management business at the American Angus Hall of Fame for 17 years. While in Missouri, he married Jenny Porter and they have three children, Drew, Aleigh, and Matthew. Jeremy and Jenny are currently owner-operators at Coleman Angus Ranch with the Coleman family in Charlo, Montana.

Following Chad's education, he continued to manage the family farm with his mother and, following the same footsteps as his father, met his life partner at the Marshall County Fair, Erica McCoy. Chad and Erica have two children, Weston Michael Haag and Tinley Sue Haag, and the fifth generation is now embarking on their own junior careers. This past year, Weston competed at the Atlantic National where he exhibited the Rex, Grand Champion Bred and Owned Bull and had the Grand Champion Bull at the Indiana State Fair, now being offered as our Lot 1 feature in this Mature Cow Herd Dispersal Sale.

On March 31, 2011, the family experienced the toughest challenge they have ever felt when Michael Paul Haag passed of an unexpected heart attack at the farm. Mike's love and passion for Angus cattle will continue to be carried on for years to come. Mike believed in the Angus cow and in his President's message in 2000 he states, "The Angus breed has never been in a stronger position than it is today. Angus cattle are on the verge of total domination. This is due to the fact they excel in the economically important traits of beef production, they deliver a superior product to the consumer and they are superior mothers." With the original motto that Mike and Peggy embodied into the logo for Pilgrim Angus, "Founded and Maintained on Great Families," Pilgrim Angus continues Mike's legacy of respecting the mother cow, doing what you love, and treating people right.

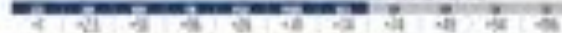

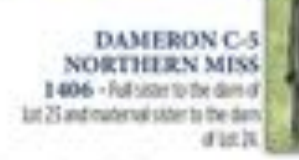
