An Introduction to: Maternal Lines

Mitchelle Ruth

There is an art to breeding cattle. Despite the scientific advances that have been made with EBVs, EPDs, performance tests, DNA tests, and the rise of genomics the breeder still can not control or explain everything that occurs around breeding and genetics. An example of these uncontrollable and sometimes unexplainable interactions is how particular maternal lines exhibit superior traits in an area consistently from generation to generation (and weaknesses in the same pattern).

This demonstration of superior traits by certain maternal lines whether it be for marbling, milk, growth, etc. occurs despite other maternal lines having extremely similar breeding or sire stacks. Even though breeders do not fully know or understand why these superior transmitting abilities occur, they have observed this in all breeds of cattle and use this knowledge in their breeding strategies.

Science has provided possible explanations for this such as mitochondrial DNA inheritance only coming from the dam, cytoplasmic inheritance theories, and epigenetics triggered in utero by the dam. If you are interested in these topics please check the links/sources below.

The superior maternal lines featured in this catalogue include the Suzutani, Hikokura, Chiyotake, Yasuyoshi, Akiko, and Namiko maternal lines to highlight a few. Careful research of these pedigrees will reveal the extreme depth and quality of the cattle organized here. This is a truly elite offering of foundation and next generation Wagyu genetics like never seen before in South Africa!

‘n Eetervaring om van te praat

In Suid Afrika is dit eens:

‘n Lekker stuk vleis op die vuur en ons is kloppisselboom.

Langs die braaivleisvuur is waar dinge gebeur van vreugdes deel, kinders bespreek , politiek ontrafel en uiteindelik ons eetervaring na die tyd deel.

Wagyu biefstuk is gewis duurder as meeste eweknië in die mark maar sal al wat persoon, wat die geleentheid gehad het om dit al te geëet het, gewis jou meedeel dat dit ‘n besondere eetervaring was en elke sent die moeite werd is. Dit is ‘n ervaring soos min en is meeste verbruikers bereid om die premie vir Wagyu te betaal.

Die geskiedenis van die hedendaagse Wagyu kan tot 1830 teruggevoer word. Tydens die Meiji-tydperk van 1868 tot 1910 is daar begin om kruisteling te doen met rasse, soos die Shorthorn, Devon, Simmentaler, Ayrshire en Angus.

Die ras word hoofsaaklik in die Kinki- en Chugoku-streke aangetref en is eers in 1944 as ‘n inheemse Japannese beesras geregistreer.

Volgens Michael Bradfield van Wagyu SA kan die ervaring die verbruiker se ervaring oor vleis permanent verander.

Die verskil gaan oor die vermoë van die ras om vet tussen die weefsel en spiere te stoor. Die vetinhoud en onversadigde vetsure wat oliensure bevat vorm ‘n besondere eetervaring. Dit is wel nie die soort vet wat hartaanvalle bevorder nie. Wagyu se vet is soortgelyk aan vette wat jy in avocado of vis sal vind.

Die Wagyu bees se karkas word in ander snitte verwerk as die algemene beeskarkas soos filet, lendeskyf of kruisskyf. Die vleis word op ‘n unieke graderingskaal verkoop, waarvan gradering nie gegrond is op ouderdom van die dier nie maar op die marmering van die vleis . Snitte se prys word daarvolgens gekoppel. In Suid Afrika vind ons graderings van 1-3 terwyl hoër graderings uitgevoer word.

Hoe hoër die gradering hoe kleiner porsies kan bedien word aangesien die vleis baie vullend raak na gelang van die marmeringsgraad .

Wagyu vleis is skaars en sal telers vir die volgende paar jaar n groter premie op goeie teelgenetik kan verwag. Volgens Schutte van Platinum Beef verwag hy ‘n stabilisering in die wagyu prys oor die volgende 5 jaar, en sal meer verbruikers die geleentheid kan geniet om die spesiale eetervaring te kan deel.

Weens die onversadigde internasionale markte maak dit vir Suid Afrikaanse Beesboere deure oop vir uitvoer. Deur Kruisteling met goeie Wagyu genetika kan boere reeds op F1 kalwers goeie marmering verkry.

Wagyu het die Wagyu sertifiseringsprogram waar geregistreeerde telers data vaslegging doen van voorsate tot en met 3 of meer generasies terug, dus kan die verbruiker deur te kyk vir die Wagyu stempel van registrasie die vleis terugseur na oorkoms en teler. Wagyu sertifiseringsprogram ondersteun streng standaarde wat op hul webtuiste beskryf word.

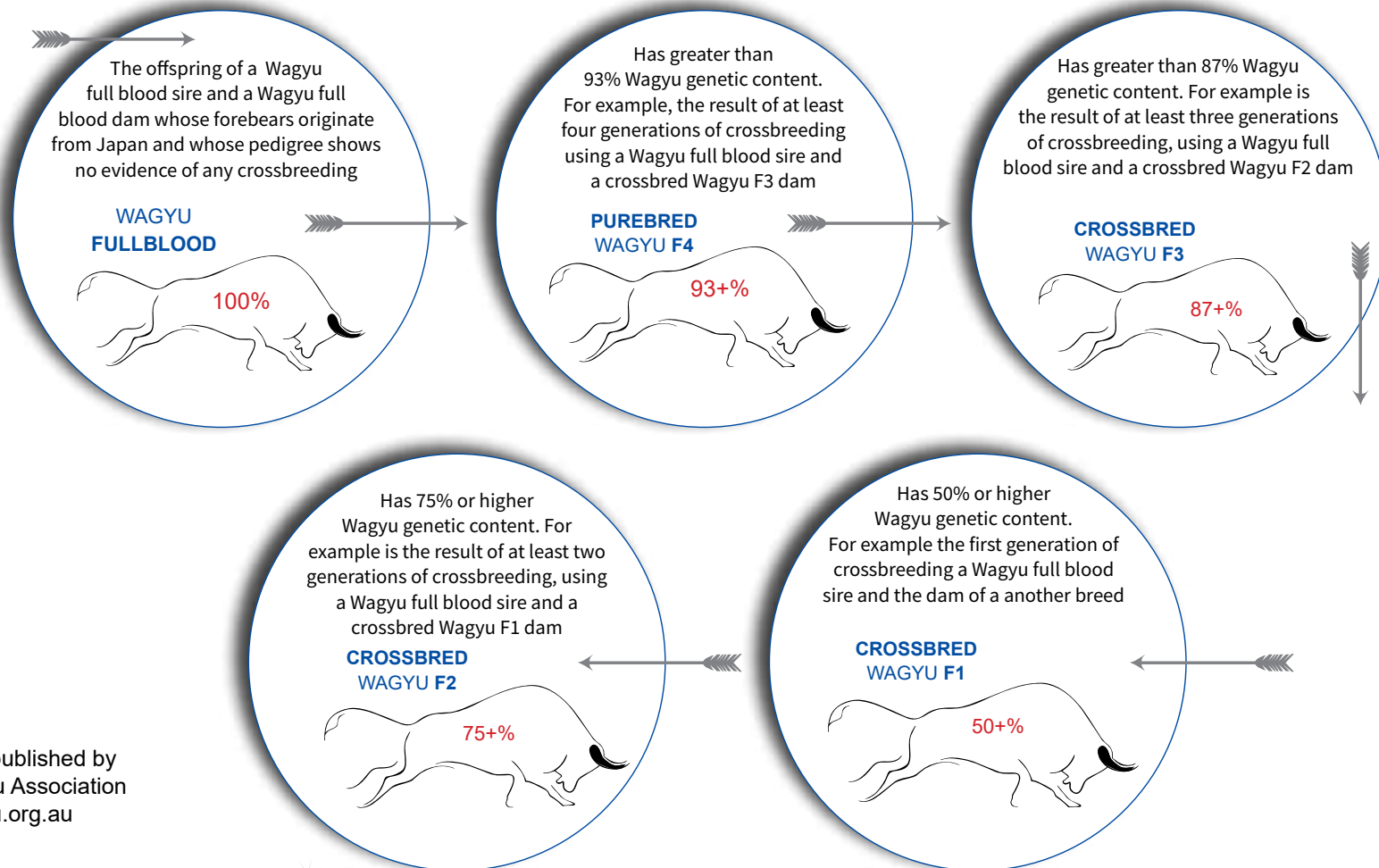

PUREBRED VS FULLBLOOD WAGYU

What are the differences between fullblood, purebred and F1, F2, F3 WAGYU in terms of the livestock?

Australian Fullblood Wagyu are 100% direct descendants of Japanese herdbook livestock, and these animals are directly comparable to those in today's Japanese home herd. DNA parent verification has confirmed this direct lineage for all animals registered in the Australia Wagyu Association Herdbook. Purebred, F3, F2 and F1 are crossbred Wagyu defined under the Wagyu Breed Trade Descriptions as:

BE IDENTIFIABLE!

To be significant in business one either has to be **FIRST, BIGGEST, BEST** or **DIFFERENT**.

The Wagyu breed checks three of these boxes - this is an incredible premise to build a brand from.

The breed was the **FIRST** to prioritize selection for marbling and tenderness and has done so successfully for around eight decades now. Because of these foundations laid by the founders in Japan, Wagyu cattle marble and their beef is tender - this is a given when compared with all other breeds of cattle.

Wagyu beef is the **BEST** red meat eating experience going and this is not a bumper sticker. It is incomparable with anything else and this quality demands a premium. Keeping it a premium and luxury product is what I believe sustains the breed long term internationally. Being a commodity is the last thing Wagyu needs to be. Cartier or Montblanc are revered because they're an aspirational luxury. Their strength is not in being plentiful or affordable but rather in being aspirational. This is Wagyu's place, on the aspirational list.

Wagyu beef is **DIFFERENT**. There is nothing like it. Even the "lower marbling" Wagyu genetics are different to the rest of the bovine pack. Differentiating a brand is such a great challenge. Wagyu breeders need to be jealous of this trait and honor the founders who showed great vision carving out a niche in what was then an absolute commodity market.

This is great news for the global Wagyu fraternity.

The challenge, however is that as amazing as these cattle are, they are still just cows.

So, the basic principles apply to Wagyu the same way as they apply to Holstein, Angus, Brahman or Charolais.

The 4 most important traits in a cattle operation (any cattle operation) are:

- FERTILITY
- LONGEVITY
- ADAPTABILITY
- EFFICIENCY

You'll notice that I didn't list:

- MILK
- MUSCLE
- GROWTH

As important as these 3 traits are, they're completely irrelevant without the foundations being laid by the first 4 I listed.

This is where as producers we need to remain mindful of making sure that the premium we can demand for Wagyu product stays higher than the cost it takes to produce them.

Tom Lasater, founder of the Beefmaster breed, famously stated that **"BREEDING CATTLE IS SIMPLE. The difficult part is keeping it simple."**

Wagyu's stake in the global beef industry is valid and real. The value they add is tangible. The product is what drives food connoisseurs to wax lyrical and diner's to use words like je ne sais quoi.

What an honor it is to play a tiny part in the propagation of the unique story of the Wagyu.

WHY BREED WAGYU?

Dr Michael Bradfield

The mission of Wagyu in South Africa is to transform the South African beef industry to be highly profitable with consumers demanding and enjoying a premium eating experience. Wagyu weaners get a premium in the market of at least 20%. Despite the current drop in weaner prices, Wagyu is still holding its own simply because it does not trade as a commodity. Wagyu meat is world renowned for its superior meat quality. Its tenderness, flavour and heavy marbling give the steak its satisfying mouthfeel. It is the feeling of the meat melting in your mouth like butter that really makes Wagyu beef an outstanding culinary experience.

How do I get into commercial Wagyu production?

There are many producers who are using Wagyu bulls or who have Artificially Inseminated (AI) many of their commercial animals with Fullblood or Purebred Wagyu semen and are looking at the opportunity to grade up over time to become a purebred herd, or to remain a commercial herd but command a premium price for their cattle. Cattle with at least 50% Wagyu content are defined as Wagyu. Preferable breeds to use to produce F1's (first cross) are the British breeds, or indigenous breeds with British breed content such as Bonsmara.

What is the difference between a Purebred and Fullblood Wagyu?

Fullblood animals trace their lineage, uninterrupted, through their pedigrees directly back to an ancestor in Japan. They are thus 100% pure Wagyu genetics and are thus considered to be part of "The original stock". Purebred Wagyu have been graded up after four generations and often include traits that are considered an advantage (such as growth or the polled gene for example).

I would like to start a Wagyu Stud, what are my options.

You can either breed F1's up to Purebreds over four generations as described above through a grading-up program. This process will take four generations of breeding if starting from scratch with commercial cattle. Only registered Fullblood or Purebred bulls can be used for breeding, either via natural mating or via the use of semen of approved bulls on cows in the upgrading program.

A quicker way for starting a Purebred or Fullblood Stud is to purchase Purebred or Fullblood females from other breeders. These females are often in calf from a Purebred or Fullblood bull. The advantage of this option is that you start breeding Purebred Wagyu's from the first calf crop and these females are often in calf from a Purebred or Fullblood bull.

Please explain the Certified Wagyu Beef (CWB) Program?

The Certified Wagyu Beef Program has been developed to ensure that all sectors of the Wagyu supply chain:

- ensure product integrity
- provide a consistent message to consumers regarding Wagyu beef as a product
- provide the Wagyu industry with the opportunity to market and brand the Wagyu product appropriately and
- protect the investment made by Wagyu South Africa members.

Using the DNA Wagyu content test, the Certified Wagyu Beef Program also assures Wagyu breed content in all sectors of the Wagyu supply chain.

Who will purchase my weaners?

Numerous feedlots and producer value chains purchase Wagyu. These include Sparta, Beefcor, Beefmaster, Cavalier foods and Morgan Beef. Wagyu South Africa (WSA) and Certified Wagyu Beef (CWB) recently announced that it has entered into a ground-breaking relationship with Morgan Beef. The agreement consists of three options namely custom feeding, a profit share system and a premium paid on weaners. SOUTH AFRICA –

Just go with it!

Ken Dungey

When Australian Ken Dungey of Lake Wagyu Cattle Company first began sending seedstock to South Africa over a decade ago, he was astounded by the enthusiasm and vision displayed by SA farmers.

“Their understanding of the possibilities that Wagyu presents is astounding,” remarked Ken, who founded his Wagyu company in 1997.

“We were Hereford breeders, but on a visit to [early Wagyu pioneers] the Hammonds, in Tasmania... we were hooked.”

Arriving on a background of the spectacular crash of a booming Australian Emu industry, the Wagyu breed had an awkward introduction into Australia. Many cattle farmers were suspicious of Wagyu, dismissing it as a mere novelty that would also crash.

However, Ken, impressed by what he had seen at the Hammonds, invested in a pure-bred Wagyu bull, producing F1 steers for the live trade to Japan. He commenced a steep learning curve to understand the breed, especially learning about the importance of genetics.

“Over the next decade there were huge strides made in understanding Wagyu, but also devastating changes to the ground rules – for instance overnight, pure-breds were no longer acceptable,” Ken remembers. The pure breeds were fine as meat, but in the late nineties the Japanese live trade was the only market for most smaller operations. It’s not an issue these days, but it was an earthquake then.

Most Wagyu breeders had “bred up” from Angus rather than import Wagyu genetics – strict Australian quarantine laws made that impractical for most. Suddenly, once-valuable animals were virtually worthless and growers had to obtain expensive “full blood” genetics from overseas. Memories of Emus returned – many went back to Angus.

“The goal posts changed often – we were dependent on Japan and they could be extremely fussy. It was their breed, after all,” says Ken ruefully. “We were groping in the dark; we did not even know about recessive genes, so when that revelation was made, once again our wonderfully pedigreed animals were suddenly worthless. However, after each trial we rebuilt and emerged stronger. It was difficult.”

On the other hand, fortune sometimes smiled on the company. Much of the Lake Wagyu herd had been based on a little-known bull called Itozurudo that suddenly became a very well known and highly-sought bull – especially in America. And Australia had the only available source of his genetics...

Nowadays the Wagyu industry in Australia has grown up to be a strong force in the overall cattle market. Eventually, Lake Wagyu Cattle Company ceased its F1 trade and began exporting Wagyu seedstock around the world, capitalizing on the deep knowledge of the breed they now possessed and the fine herd they had built. These days, Lake Wagyu Cattle Company animals feature in the Wagyu herds on every continent except Antarctica.



“We get clients from all over letting us know about their latest prize or auction result. We are very proud of our cattle,” says Ken “and it’s nice to share.” In Africa, LWCC forged strong links with Embryo Plus, who manage all Lake Wagyu seedstock and its SA herd. “We love EP,” says Ken. “They epitomize everything about this country and its cattle breeders in particular. You guys are amazing.”

Ken is particularly impressed with the way S.A. breeders have set about educating the public and spreading the good news about the breed. “It took years to get the word out in Australia – the anti-cholesterol fad had us eating shoe-leather for decades. But the Wagyu enthusiasts here are way ahead of Australia already in educating the public.”

“South Africa is our favourite market,” he went on. “Nowhere else in the world have I seen such professionalism and enthusiasm to promote and share the Wagyu experience. Best of all, you haven’t had to go through those same dramas we did. You have your own challenges as well, but you’re able to... **just go with it!**”

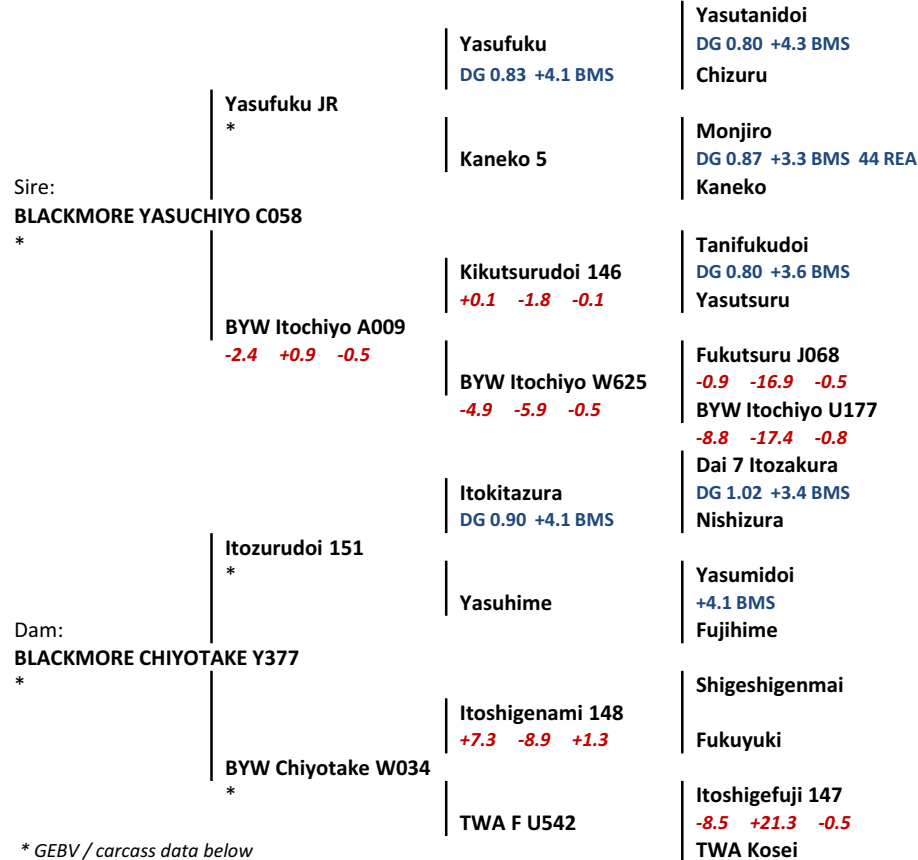

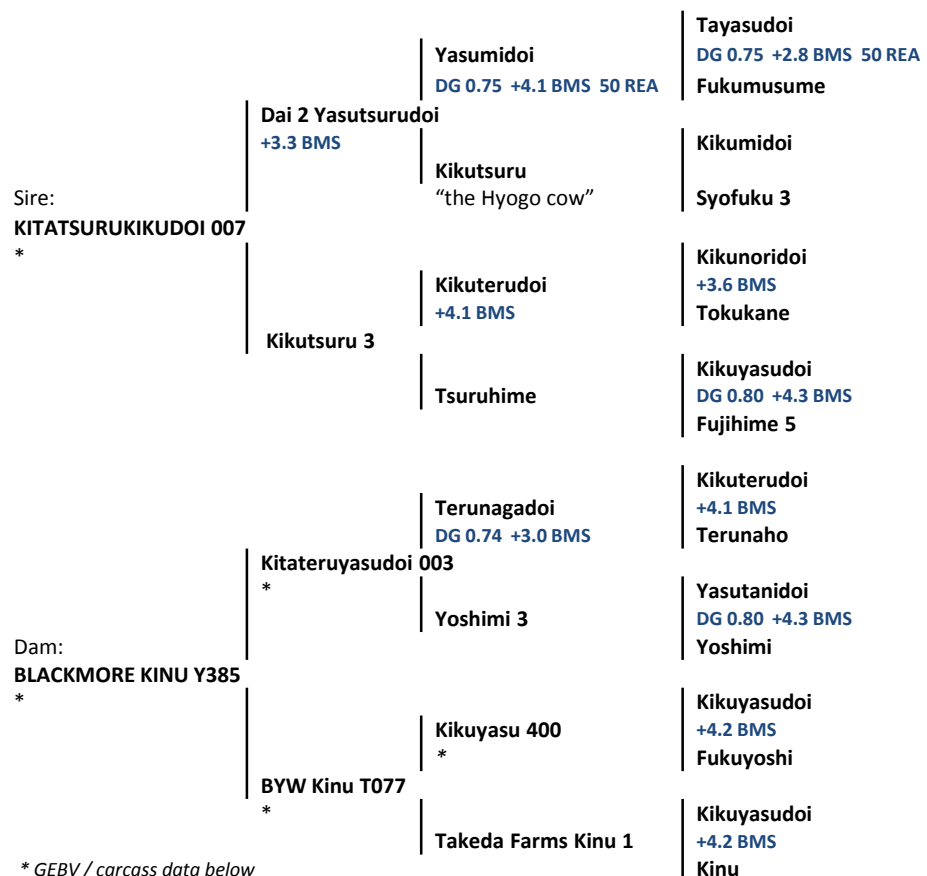

The Northern White Rhino is a subspecies to the Southern White Rhino. There are only 2 cows left in the world and they are not capable of natural reproduction. However various semen samples and cell-cultures have been saved in various parts of the world.

This remarkable team of Experts in their fields has taken the mammoth task to save our Northern White Rhino for generations to come.

The aim is to develop a robust protocol and to optimize a procedure of harvesting maturing oocytes, fertilization of oocytes and following embryo transfers into Southern White Rhinos (SWR).

When the process is standardized on the close relatives of the Northern White Rhino, the team will aim to harvest oocytes from the last Northern White Rhino female and fertilize them with northern white rhino semen, generate embryos and cryo-preserve them or transfer them directly into SWR surrogate mothers.



At the same time the development of the technique will assist with the breeding of southern white rhino that has shown to have problems breeding in captivity. The possible use of NWR genetics on SWR is also discussed to diversify the genetics of the SWR.

Genetic material (tissue samples and semen) of numerous Northern White Rhinos have been cryo-preserved (including semen of Sudan and other genetic material) already at various places around the world. Most institutions have shown interest and willingness to participate/cooperate should there be proven success with various ARTs in the SWR. During the project, more sets of samples will be collected for research and reproduction purposes.



Assisted reproduction technologies (ARTs) that is needed, has to be developed in the process for rhino. These specific techniques might not all be used for the NWR but will be good to develop them to help with other rhino species and later with ART in SWR.

The African Rhino Specialists Group has also expressed their wishes to produce inter-crosses between the SWR and the NWR. Therefore perfecting all these techniques will have other benefits as well. One can utilise the NWR semen to a maximum by not only fertilise the NWR oocytes but also numerous SWR oocytes simultaneous.

These techniques are not placed in order of preference but rather in order of easiest to develop to the most advanced:

- Semen collection and freezing
- Testicular and ovarian biopsies and freezing of these samples.
- Embryo collection (flush) techniques
- Embryo transfer
- Ovum Pick Up
- IVEP – In Vitro Embryo Production
 - IVEM (maturation)
 - IVF (fertilisation)
 - IVC (culture)
- Nuclear transfer (cloning)
- iPS

OFFICIAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

(in terms of article 45 of Act 68 of 2008 with regulations 18-38)

AUCTIONS HELD BY ANDRÉ KOCK & SEUN/SON BK.

WHEREAS auctions held by André Kock & Seun BK (the AUCTIONEER) pertaining to the selling of livestock (hereinafter referred to as GOODS) shall in all material times hereto be subjected to the terms and conditions of sale set forth hereinafter which terms and conditions shall be binding on all buyers, sellers or anyone present. AND WHEREAS the AUCTIONEER reserves the right to amend and/or supplement these terms and conditions by giving verbal notice before or during the auction, and/or by amending, and/or or supplementing the terms and conditions applicable to this agreement, and/or the relevant part thereof.

NOW AND THEREFORE THE PARTIES UNDERTAKE AS FOLLOWS:

1. These conditions of sale do not affect the rights or responsibilities that was brought about between the AUCTIONEER and the seller.
2. The AUCTIONEER has the right to bid on behalf of the owner of the GOODS as well as on behalf of André Kock & Seun BK.
3. When GOODS are offered to be sold at the auction in lots, each lot should be deemed a separate transaction, unless proven otherwise.
4. Any person acting on behalf of a Company, Private Corporation, Trust, Firm, Organisation or Corporation (meaning "another person"), WILL have written authorisation that proves that he/she has the authority to act on behalf of somebody else and the authorisation should contain the following:
 - 4.1. When the buyer is bidding on behalf of another buyer, the authorisation must be stated on an official header of the original buyer which must be accompanied by a certified Resolution from the buyer to empower him as such;
 - 4.2. The total amount of how much can be spend;
 - 4.3. The goods and/or livestock to be bought must be specified;
 - 4.4. The maximum price to be paid for the specified goods and/or livestock must reflect and taken into account the Rand-per-Kilogram price excluding VAT.
5. All buyers must register his or her principal's (where applicable) identity in terms of Chapter 1 of the Financial Intelligence Centre Act 28 of 2001 as verification of their identity which must be signed accordingly. The buyer will sign the principal's invoice on behalf of the real buyer to reflect both their identities on the invoice documentation.
6. No bids will be accepted from any bidder that has not followed the correct procedures to register in accordance to the terms of Regulation 26 and whose name or identity does not appear on the bidder's records.

The AUCTIONEER hereby declares to pay all monies due, minus the agreed upon commission and other expenses, into his trust account when the AUCTIONEER is not the owner of legitimate holder or owner of the goods and/or livestock.

7. The AUCTIONEER will announce the rules of the auction during the event if the sale of the goods is sold under normal circumstances and voluntary by the owner.
8. The buyers' records referred to in Regulation 26 and the venture in terms of Regulation 28 (4) is available for inspection during normal business hours.
9. The AUCTIONEER is the organiser of the bidding processes and will use his own discretion in case where any discrepancies arises. Subject to the AUCTIONEERS discretion, he has the right to reject any bid coupled with a reserve price of GOODS put in place by the seller. The GOODS will then be sold to the highest bidder.
10. All sales shall be strictly CASH unless the buyer can prove that a legal buyers' agreement was reached before the auction between him and the auctioneer.



11. If auction credit was granted to a buyer that has not entered into a buyers' agreement before the auction, it is stipulated that the terms and conditions relevant to the AUCTIONEERS' buyers' agreement as if it was agreed upon. However, no GOODS will be removed before such an agreement with all its terms and agreements was agreed to and duly signed.
12. If the AUCTIONEER granted credit to the buyer before or during the auction and the buyer refuses or neglect to sign a buyers' agreement, the granted credit will expire with immediate effect. The buyer then must pay cash before the GOODS are removed from the auction area. If the GOODS have already been removed, the AUCTIONEER has the same rights as referred to in paragraph 16. All monies owed by the buyer should then be paid plus prime interest retrospectively to the date of the auction and the AUCTIONEER can capitalise on the interest monthly.
13. No GOODS may be removed from the area before the buyer who won the bid, issued a 'BUYERS' invoice which were duly signed, and/or the agreement conditions mentioned in ad paragraphs 13 and 14 have been fulfilled.
14. Should the buyer remove the GOODS without honouring the conditions as mentioned in paragraphs 13 and 14, and/or if he paid per cheque and the cheque is returned or not accepted by a bank, the AUCTIONEER has the right to impound the GOODS straight away for it to be re-auctioned at the sole cost and risk of the buyer. The net proceeds of this auction, after deduction of all costs and safekeeping of impounded GOODS, as well as any cost incurred by the AUCTIONEER, will be credited to the buyer's account with the express understanding that he stays responsible for any outstanding monies including interest as mentioned in ad paragraph 14 which has absolutely no effect on the conditions addressed in ad paragraphs 33 and 34.
15. If the opposite is proven, the buyer acknowledges the goods are sold voetstoots and that the AUCTIONEER shall not be bound by any guarantee of whatsoever nature completed before the sale.
16. The AUCTIONEER shall not be responsible for any damage caused by or to the GOODS while under his supervision or the supervision of his employees, irrespective of whether such damages was caused by negligence on the part of AUCTIONEER and/or his employees of whatsoever nature. For the purpose hereof, damage also means and/or includes infection and/or any ailment of whatsoever nature to any livestock which may have arisen during and/or before the sale.
17. From the moment of acceptance of the buyers offer by the auctioneer, all risks shall automatically pass to the buyer.
18. Any person bringing wild or dangerous animals to the auction area, will be held responsible for any injuries or damages caused to any person or property. The AUCTIONEER cannot be held responsible for any such incidents and is unconditionally indemnified from any such incidents or injuries.
19. No BONA FIDE mistake made by the AUCTIONEER shall be binding on the AUCTIONEER, seller or buyer.
20. Any entries made by die AUCTIONEER in the auction documents shall be conclusive evidence of GOODS sold and/or bought at the auction.
21. The right of admission to auctions are held by the AUCTIONEER and he can refuse entry to the auction area at his sole behest without giving specific reasons.
22. All persons entering the auctions area, do so at their own risk and the AUCTIONEER does not take any responsibility for any damages and/or injuries to property and people on the premises even though it might have been caused by the negligence of the AUCTIONEER or his employees.
23. If the seller gives the buyer a postponement of payment, it is done at the seller's own risk if it does not harm the AUCTIONEER'S right of selling conditions, and/or imperilling the AUCTIONEER'S agreement rights. Moreover, the foregoing shall not vary the conditions of sale and/or changes to the agreement to sell. Both the seller and buyer expressly and confirm that they are bound by the stipulations, terms and conditions as stated in this agreement.
24. No rights of debt comparisons between the seller and buyer or between the buyer and AUCTIONEER would be recognised and the seller expressly negate his right to apply any such comparisons. The seller is responsible to pay the AUCTIONEER for GOODS bought even if a dispute between the two parties has arisen. This buyer retains the right to take legal action against the seller.
 - 24.1 The AUCTIONEER undertakes to pay the seller the amount gotten for GOODS on sale. The AUCTIONEER has the right to calculate his commission at a legal premium rate as agreed upon in writing as well as bring into account other monies that are due to him by the seller.
 - 24.2 The seller unconditionally safeguards the AUCTIONEER against any possible claims the buyer of the GOODS might instigate against the AUCTIONEER because of guarantees of representation made by the seller to the buyer.
 - 24.3 The seller guarantees that he is the owner of the goods on sale and if not so, that the owner gave him permission and authorisation to sell and later transfer the propriety rights to the seller. If he does not have the necessary powers, he must undertake to honour all responsibilities towards the AUCTIONEER as if he was the owner or had authority.
 - 24.4 A seller of GOODS who did not have authorisation from the owner to sell GOODS indemnify the AUCTIONEER unconditionally against any claims which the rightful owner or buyer might start have against the AUCTIONEER after the transaction without first obtaining the necessary authorisation.
25. Nevertheless, the AUCTIONEER does not guarantee the buyer property rights of taking possession or safekeeping of the goods.
26. The seller must immediately, after the sale of the goods, sign the AUCTIONEERS SELLER'S invoice as explained in paragraph 24.1.
27. The AUCTIONEER has the right to decline to sell anything on behalf of a seller at the auction.
28. When the AUCTIONEER pays the amount of sale of the GOODS to the seller, he cedes to the seller all rights, title and all interest claims benefited from the sale of the goods as well as any beneficial rights that he might have over the GOODS to the AUCTIONEER if the buyer has credit to pay for the goods.
29. Bestowing to article 49(2) of Act 12 of 1975, the SELLER gives permission that the livestock sold by him at the auction, shall be sold by the AUCTIONEER together with other animals to be sold at the auction.



30. Ownership of the GOODS are reserved until payment of the full outstanding purchase prices are paid and all risk of whatever nature in and to the GOODS, shall pass to the buyer on acceptance of the buyer's offer by die AUCTIONEER.
31. From the moment of acceptance of the buyer's offer, the seller transfers all rights to the GOODS over go the AUCTIONEER if the BUYER has settled for credit like explained in paragraphs 13 and 14. By doing this, the seller and buyer of the goods agree that the right to the property, are transferred to the AUCTIONEER even though the buyer might already have been in the physical possession of the goods.
32. The buyer confirms that the AUCTIONEER keeps possession of the GOODS until payment of the full purchase price, interest and other costs are paid for and is not further seen as security for the conditions of sale. The seller will transfer his/her rights over to the AUCTIONEER as well as the title and bookkeeping records.
33. The BUYER hereby undertake as follows:
 - 33.1.1. he must give the AUCTIONEER, within three days hereof, a written demand to the BUYER for a complete list of debtors with their full names, addresses, their professions and an indication of how much is owed to them, details on any other monies owed, title deeds and conditions regarding any open account of credit.
 - 33.1.2. to present on demand bank drafts, promises, cheques, title deeds and any other securities as referred to in sub paragraph 34.1.1, ceded and handed over, properly endorsed to the AUCTIONEER in such a manner the he becomes the rightful owner of the GOODS and has the right to force payment from the buyer;
 - 33.1.3. to give permission and the right to the AUCTIONEER or his representative to have access during normal business hours, to any documents, correspondence, receipts, books, negotiations and any information regarding any debtors.;
 - 33.1.4. give permission to the AUCTIONEER to have access to all information about any debtors to collect such debt
- 33.2. With this, the buyer gives his permission to the AUCTIONEER to inform debtors of the cession.
- 33.3. The AUCTIONEER hereby accepts the mentioned cession.
34. The terms and conditions in the AUCTIONEERS' deed of sale, of which a copy is available on request at the auction, is binding on all BUYERS whatever agreement he signed to bid at the auction. The BUYER is bound by the agreement and may request to sign such documentation if he did not do so before the auction.
35. Each buyer must furnish his full physical and postal address to the AUCTIONEER and if he is buying on behalf of a third party, firm, partnership trust or judicial body, also the full address if such principal.
36. If the BUYER should request the auctioneer to arrange for the safe keeping of the GOODS and/or transportation thereof, he shall be pay the costs involved together with any interest as referred to in paragraph 14 to the AUCTIONEER on request. If such arrangements are made with a third party, the AUCTIONEER undertakes as the agent of the BUYER and the BUYER shall be responsible to such third party for the relevant costs. The BUYER indemnifies the AUCTIONEER against any claim which the third party may have against the AUCTIONEER.
